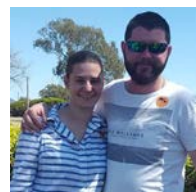
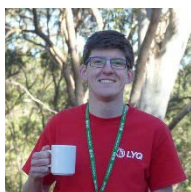

## What to bring:
