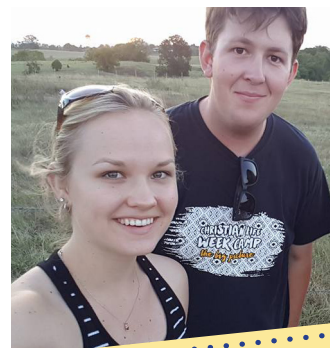
1 THEME NIGHT
